What stands out is;

- The way in which Loch Arthur Farm Shop and Café has become a destination, a meeting place, a focal point in people's social lives
- The incredible sense of Community that has grown in and around the shop and its many loyal customers and supporters

A lot of the success of our kitchen has been due to the calm & experienced presence of our dear Canadian friend, Paula, who has been guiding the kitchen for the past two years and who will, sadly for us, be returning to her homeland early next year. So, once again, Christmas is looming and we look forward to welcoming you into the shop to browse, socialise, eat, drink, enjoy and revel in the wonderful offerings.

WHAT'S HAPPENING WITH CHEESE

We have decided, after difficult events earlier in the year, to cease production of Criffel and Kebbuck for the time being. This is a bit heart-breaking for us and very disappointing for many. However, we are now producing 2 new cheeses alongside our Farmhouse Cheese and Crannog; a firm, Dutch-style cheese called Killywhan and a simple, 'Feta-style' salad cheese. 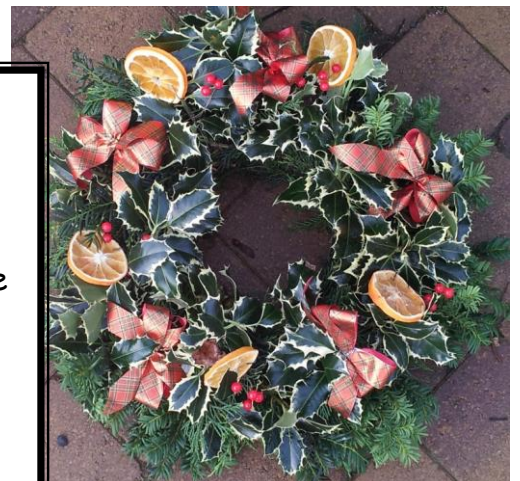
